Tal Fox Proposal

Musical Theatre Showcase for Kids & Teens (Ages 8-15)

Session 1: June 21st-June 25th. 9:30am-2pm

This Pop-Rock Musical Theatre Camp will get kids singing and moving right away. In 1-week, we will put together a showcase of songs from the pop-rock musical theatre canon from shows like Mean Girls, Mamma Mia, Hamilton, Rent, and more!

Tuition has yet to be confirmed, but I believe it'll be around \$350 per student. Minimum: 10 students

Session 2: July 12th-July 30th M-F. 9:30am-2pm

In this longer 2-week session, students will learn more comprehensive numbers from musical theater from the Golden Age to now! They will be asked to sing, dance, and act in groups, duets, and solos, ultimately putting on a showcase for family and friends.

Tuition has yet to be confirmed, but I believe it'll be around \$650 per student. Minimum: 10 students

Adult Musical Theatre Analysis and Showcase

July 12th-July 30th M-F, 5-7:30pm

In this class, students will work through 2 musical theater solos with an emphasis on storytelling and acting technique. After a challenging year in quarantine, students will have the opportunity to connect to one another and explore their thoughts and feelings through song. A piano accompanist will be provided in class. We will hold a showcase for family and friends at the end of the session, with each student presenting a solo.

Tuition has yet to be confirmed, but I believe it'll be around \$275 per student. Minimum: 8 students
