The Hidden Hills Theatre Committee Meeting was called to order at 10:05 by Karleen Basch, chairwoman. There was a motion of approval of the May minutes. The committee welcomed Cary Brackett as the new Hidden Hills Association Manager, as Shannon Moore has resigned. Karleen discussed Tal Fox and her workshops, and there were no sign-ups for her summer adult workshops nor kids musical theatre workshops. David Stanley offered to help and it was agreed upon that over the summer, a few members of the committee would go through storage unit.

David Stanley addressed the committee in regards to his upcoming "Valentine Musicale" and that he needed support with this production, post Covid, in promoting it and getting ticket sales. Tamika offered to post information on FB, as Karleen and Farnaz agreed to send information electronically. Debbee Klein offered to set up a booth at the Hidden Hills Market and sell tickets for the production. David sated that there would be food trucks and beverages/snacks at both performances. He thanked the committee for their help and volunteerism.
