Trails Reports

- Are they still using metal clips for sand bags. Lonna found 6 clips on the trail from sand bags. Lonna suggested zip ties instead of metal clips.
- Regrade trail behind Lonna's house and add an additional row of sand bags to prevent flooding to barns and homes below trail. Lonna will send an email of the history of the trail. Sarah suggested adding the trail to a major fix when we do trail repairs. Damage to the trail is due to construction from Edison.
- Hole on saddle creek trail from rain. Trail needs to be cleaned up from rain and recent construction.
