SUMMER EQUESTRIAN CARE TIPS

AS THE WEATHER HEATS UP, HERE ARE A FEW TIPS TO KEEP YOUR EQUINE FRIEND HAPPY, SAFE AND COMFORTABLE:

WATER – if possible, place water containers in the shade. Even when they are in the shade, they will heat up during the day, so always check the temperature of the water. Water that is too warm will discourage your horse from drinking enough, and can potentially cause them to colic. You can dump out some or all of their water and add fresh cool water as needed. It should go without saying, but it is also important that water is available at all times and is fresh and clean.

Making sure that your horses have access to salt every day can also encourage them to stay well hydrated in the heat. Many horses do well with free choice salt, but some do better with a small amount offered every day. (Do not add salt to their water.)

AUTOMATIC WATERERS – the above holds true for automatic waterers as well. Make sure that the water coming out is not hot, which can happen if the pipe bringing in water is in the sun or along a hot wall or roof.

SHELTER – make sure that all animals have a shady place to get out of the sun, and make sure that shade is available throughout the day.

FANS – fans can provide relief from insects as well as a cooling breeze. Make sure that the fans are rated for outside use, and that your animals cannot tip them over or chew the cord.

Special note for horse owners: the number one cause of barn fires in the summer is inexpensive box fans. Since these fans are designed for indoor use, their motors are not sealed, which means that dust and moisture can get inside, causing them to overheat and ultimately cause a fire. If you have fans in your barn, make sure that they are designed for outdoor use, and that the motors are sealed. Search for industrial, agricultural or barn fans. Also important, make sure that your horse cannot reach the electrical cord!

FLIES – biting flies and other insects can make our animals (and us!) miserable. There are several things that you can do to help. Keep your animal's living quarters as clean and dry as possible, and make sure animal waste is placed in covered containers. Flies love a still, moist environment, so fans can really help.

Use fly repellents, fly masks and sheets as needed, and make sure that they are kept clean and in good working order. For horses that are extremely sensitive to biting insects, you can also consider trying feed supplements that are designed to make your horse undesirable to flies. Also, make sure that your horses are current on their West Nile Virus vaccines- the mosquitoes are out in force these days!

Skin Care - horses with white and pink areas on their face and body can suffer from sunburn. Consider using a sunscreen made specifically for horses.

EXERCISE - try to plan exercise events in the morning if possible, since this is the coolest time of the day.

We hope these hot weather tips help keep your horse happy, cool and comfortable!






