EQUESTRIAN SERVICES TIP OF THE MONTH

FOCUS ON THE HOOF - THRUSH -

HELPFUL TIPS FOR YOU & YOUR HORSE

Thrush is an infection that occurs in the sole of a horse's hoof, particularly in the frog region. It is caused by bacteria that thrive in wet conditions, so all this wet weather we have been having creates the perfect conditions for thrush to thrive. The affected areas are generally moist, with a thick black discharge and a very bad smell evident when you start to clean out the hoof sole.

Most horse owners can manage a mild case of thrush without veterinary assistance. Your farrier can help clean up and pare away diseased areas of the frog and surrounding area, which will help get the infection under control. Then, apply one of the many topical products available for use against thrush. The goal of these products is to kill the bacteria and dry out the sole of the hoof. Now is also a good time to make any management changes necessary to keep your horse's hooves cleaner and dryer. This includes dry bedding, daily mucking, regular exercise as well as regularly picking out the hoof soles.

Even if you cannot control how wet your horse's hooves are right now, daily cleaning and application of thrush treatments will help control the thrush and hopefully prevent it from becoming a more serious and painful infection. If the condition doesn't appear to respond to at-home treatment, or your horse seems painful or lame, it may be time to call the vet.




