SUMMER EQUESTRIAN TIPS

As the weather heats up, here are a few tips to keep your equine friend happy, safe and comfortable:

- » FANS did you know that the No. 1 cause of barn fires in the summer is inexpensive box fans that are designed for indoor use? Because the motors in these fans are not sealed, dust and dirt can get inside, making them overheat and ultimately cause a fire. If you have fans in your barn, ensure that they are designed for outdoor use and that the motors are sealed.
- » WATER place water troughs in the shade. When they are in the sun, they may heat up causing horses to refuse to drink, which can .potentially cause colic. Adding electrolytes to daily supplements can also encourage horses to drink and stay well hydrated in the heat.
- » SHELTER make sure that horses have a shady place to stand, especially during the middle of the day.
- » FLIES are rampant in the summer. There are several things you can do to help. Notably, keep your barn clean, and pick up manure several times per day and place it in covered containers. Use fly repellents and sheets as needed, and also consider supplements that are designed to make your horses undesirable to flies

TWO PROPOSED RULE CHANGES TO BE CONSIDERED

You will no doubt recall that last year the Board passed a rule change prohibiting certain work on Saturdays. The first go-round included a restriction on gardeners and other noisy work to the hours of 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. However, the overwhelming majority of comments from residents opposed such a restriction, so the Board did not restrict gardeners at that time. The subject has come up again and the Board will once again be considering a rule change restricting gardeners and tree trimmers to the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays.

The Board will also be considering adding Christmas Eve to the list of "no work" holidays.

Following are the proposed rule changes. Additions are bold and underlined. Deletions are lined out. These changes will be voted on by the Board at the July 16, 2019 meeting.

Proposed change to Rules & Regulations:

5.4. Construction Schedule. Approved construction is limited to Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., except that gardeners and tree trimmers are limited to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays. No construction is permitted on Sundays or holidays, and no construction is permitted on Major Remodels or new homes on Saturdays. For purposes of gate entry, "construction" includes, without limitation, gardening, pool service, and other interior and exterior workers. Admitting workers on a Sunday or holiday, permitting gardeners and tree trimmers to remain in the community past 4:00 p.m. on a Saturday, or admitting workers on a Saturday to properties with new homes or Major Remodels underway, constitutes a violation of this provision.

Proposed change to Gate Operations Manual:

6.5 Tradespeople. Tradespeople, including contractors, gardeners, pool service, vendors, etc., have limited hours for conducting work or business within the community.

Saturdays - EXCEPT FOR PROPERTIES APPROVED FOR WORK BY THE ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE	8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
Sundays and Holidays	No entry permitted except for emergencies (plumb- ing, electrical, etc.) where authorization for entry is approved by a Gate Committee member or Associa- tion Board Member
Round Meadow Gate	No entry permitted at the Round Meadow Gate until 9:00 a.m. when school is in session
PROPERTIES APPROVED FOR WORK BY THE ARCHI- TECTURAL COMMITTEE	*7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday only. A list of Properties with Architectural Committee approval will be provided to the Gate Operations Officers. Except in emergencies, all visitors to those Properties will be denied.

a. The hours of entry for Tradespeople are limited to the following:

d. Admittance on Saturdays. Only limited construction-related activity is permitted in the community on Saturdays. No admittance will be granted for any vehicle to access property where the owner is engaged in a work that requires or has received Architectural Committee approval. A list of such properties will be provided to the Gate Operations Officers each Friday, and no admittance will be permitted by the Officers to those properties on Saturdays. Additionally, no large commercial vehicles or heavy pieces of equipment will be admitted on Saturdays, nor may any such equipment be used in the community on Saturdays. Finally, gardeners and tree trimmers will only be admitted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.




